Topic:

The Honor of the Glory

SCRIPTURE: *“What is man, that thou art mindful of him?
and the son of man, that thou visitest him? For thou hast made
him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him
with glory and honour.” Psalm 8:4-5*

THOUGHT FOR THE DAY: The glory of God places you
on a platform of honor and distinction.

MESSAGE

Honor is a byproduct of walking in God's glory. When His glory rests upon you, shame becomes a thing of the past. Honor is your portion in life, not reproach. God's design for His children is to reflect His nature, which is full of glory. *God didn't crown you with mediocrity; He crowned you with glory and honor to reflect His excellence and purpose* Psalm 8:5 reveals that man was created to be a carrier of glory and honor. You are not ordinary; you are a reflection of God's excellence. The world should see God's majesty through you. Glory represents the manifest presence and nature of God—the essence of His majesty revealed. It is His weighty

splendor imparted to us. Glory is not earned; it is bestowed as part of our divine heritage. God crowned humanity with glory and honor to reflect His image and fulfill His purposes (*Genesis 1:26-28*). The crown of glory is not about who you are but whose you are.

REFLECTION:

1. Refuse to accept anything less than the honor God has designed for you.
2. Ask God daily to crown your efforts with His glory and honor.

PRAYER:

Lord, I thank You for making me a carrier of Your glory. Help me to reflect Your honor in all I do in Jesus' Name. Amen.

DAILY PURPOSE NOTE:

You were created for honor, not reproach; walk with this consciousness today.

DAILY PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

You shall wear the crown of glory and honor this year.
Shame and reproach shall not find you in Jesus' Name!
